Young Meadows Presbyterian Church (PCA) Position Description Minister to Youth

The Minister to Youth is the primary staff responsible for the outreach and discipleship of youth. His commitment is two-fold: to encourage a community within Youth Meadows of those committed to following Jesus Christ while also seeking to minister the love of Jesus Christ to those outside of the community of Young Meadows. Candidates must have a growing relationship with Christ, a heart for and a sense of calling to youth ministries and a Kingdom perspective.

Specific responsibilities of the Minister to Youth are as follows:

- Have a definite plan for leading youth to grow in discipleship. Would include developing and executive large group, small group, and one on one discipleship, as well as fellowship activities.
- Invite youth into homes regularly for fellowship events.
- Encourage the integration of youth into other ministries of the church; (fellowship lunches, Sunday School, Children's church, Sports Camp, etc)
- Oversee quarterly Youth Parent Oversight team and Youth Leadership Ministry Team to help ensure the vision of the youth ministry is being pursued.
- Improve and ensure positive and proactive communication with youth, parents, volunteers and reports to the church regarding youth ministry activities.
- Foster discipleship relationships with middle school and high school athletic teams.
- Serve as a liaison between Young Meadows and surrounding middle and high school athletic teams.
- Initiate, coordinate, and implement events that seek to foster relationships between families of local schools and Young Meadows Members.
- Integrate and synergize teenagers of local middle and high schools with teenagers involved in Young Meadows.
- Prepare for and participate in weekly staff meeting.
- Prepare weekly time sheets accounting for supervising pastor.
- Develop, plan communicate and participate in Youth Seasonal Retreat with other PCA churches.

Ministry Heart and Attitude: Candidates must do these tasks with a God given desire and passion. Their character needs to be above reproach and their life needs to be an example of grace given godliness. They must be able to connect with youth with godly compassion. In addition to being excited about such a ministry, they need to be teachable, humble and faithful.
