PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONS

To pastor and provide leadership for the overall ministry of evangelism, outreach and assimilation and missions for Trinity Presbyterian Church. Work effectively with the Coordinator of Missions.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Oversee, provide pastoral vision and lead Trinity's Ministry of Outreach and Assimilation in conjunction with the Ministry of Outreach Committee.**
 - Coordinate with the Chairman, Ministry of Outreach to plan and lead meetings, prepare agendas and organize all business properly before the meeting and oversee preparation of minutes for the Session, including all action items
 - Develop and maintain a comprehensive program of outreach and evangelism that will draw people to worship, fellowship, and membership at Trinity Church.
 - Model and lead evangelistic endeavors with a view of training and equipping laymen to share the gospel.
 - Disciple those who have leadership and teaching abilities to assume leadership roles so as to multiply evangelistic efforts of the church.
 - Develop and maintain a comprehensive visitor follow-up ministry that will engage people in continued worship and fellowship such that they become members who are fully assimilated into the ministries of the church.
 - Oversee and coordinate church outreach publications and advertisements.
- **Provide pastoral oversight to Trinity's Ministry of Missions with assistance from the Missions Coordinator and in conjunction with the Missions Board.**
 - Oversee a comprehensive missions ministry that will engage the congregation in sending and supporting international and local missionaries in faithfulness to the Great Commission.
 - Establish through preaching, teaching and mentoring means by which congregational members respond to the call to serve as church supported missionaries.
 - Oversee local and short-term missions trips, lead by example, and develop future trip leaders who will engage members in trips that stimulate lifetime commitments to global missions.
 - Oversee selection, interviewing and budgeting to support current and future missionaries in accordance with the stated 24:14 missions priorities.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provide input, leadership and vision as a member of the Executive Ministry Team.
2. Work to develop a Biblical world and life view in the congregation.
3. Work as a team with other staff personnel: take up slack in general areas of ministry, develop relationships with others on staff, and give aid and input to all other areas of ministry.
4. Lead worship on a rotation basis with the other ministers.
5. Teach and preach as is appropriate and agreeable with the Senior Minister.
6. Committee participation as deemed necessary.
7. Pastoral care when needed.
8. Be involved in premarital counseling rotation as needed.
9. Serve as a pastoral consultant with regard to congregational care.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. A seminary graduate and ordained in the P.C.A. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Session.
2. A man of deep spiritual life, of prayer, and of holy conduct.
3. Able to sign the Statement of Faith and to be loyal to the Westminster Confession of Faith.
4. An effective communicator both in preaching and teaching.

5. Have a visible heart for people; to be friendly and outgoing.
6. A model head of his home and family.

COMPENSATION

Salary and other benefits will be determined by the Session after input from the Senior Minister, the Chairman of Administration and the Church Administrator. Vacation periods, insurance coverage, pension and other benefits are indicated in the written policy that is reviewed and updated by the Ministry of Administration periodically.
