Position Summary:

- Maintain and develop a comprehensive, biblically based ministry to students and their families; oversee their spiritual formation, ensuring they are taught to worship God, learn and obey God's Word, witness through both word and deed, serve the congregation and participate in His church.
- Provide oversight and support to the community group ministry.
- Assist the Senior Pastor as needed in general ministry responsibilities.

Accountability:

- Under guidance of the Senior Pastor for ministry development, direction, and implementation.
- Under authority of the Session for overall ministry responsibilities.

Major Duties & Responsibilities:

Student and Family Ministry:

- Develop and communicate vision for spiritual formation for the student ministry, both middle school (5th-8th grade) and high school (9th -12th grade).
- Oversee all aspects of the maintenance and growth of the student ministry.
- Recruit, equip, and lead adult volunteers and parents in the implementation of the ministry vision.
- Develop & lead specific programs, bible studies, and activities with students and their parents that will further the ministry vision and goals.
- Develop & oversee community building and outreach events for students and their families (e.g. sports ministry, family picnics, etc.)
- Visit students in their homes and at school events to build personal relationships.
- Develop discipleship opportunities for individuals and small groups that provide deeper spiritual formation and student leadership development.
- Provide primary pastoral care to students & their families in difficult times.

Community Group Ministry:

- Provide pastoral leadership and support for the community groups and community group leaders.
- Recruit and train new community group leaders.
- Provide support and direction for particular interest groups, such as the mom's group and the men's group.

- Develop and maintain a library of recommended community group resources and bible study guides.

General Pastoral Ministry:

- Preaching & worship leadership as requested by the Senior Pastor.
- Flock oversight and community group involvement.
- Provide counseling as needed.
- Assist with pastoral visitation in coordination with the Senior Pastor.
- Presbytery and denominational involvement.
- Coordinate with Senior Pastor to continue to develop appropriate outreach strategies.
- Under direction of Senior Pastor, help teach seminars and classes as needed (i.e. membership seminar, adult education classes, introductions to Christianity, etc.).
- Consult and assist with the children's ministry as needed.
- Additional ministry possible based on the experience and gifts of the individual.

Character & Conduct Qualifications

- Leads a disciplined life of daily fellowship with God and bible study
- Evidences biblical character in personal life, family relationships and ministry
- Desires to grow both spiritually and professionally
- Has a genuine heart for shepherding both the students and the wider congregation.
- Passionately shares faith with unbelievers
- Remains free from addictions
- Is a seminary graduate
- Holds biblical convictions in accord with the standards of the Presbyterian Church in America

Working Schedule:
