- Assist in discipleship development, serving as teacher in the different Sunday school programs
- Initiate outreach by leading home Bible studies for reaching the community
- Plan or assist in planning local outreach opportunities that help our church demonstrate the love of Jesus to our community
- Pray with church members and guests in times of need and as a part of the ongoing prayer efforts of the congregation
- Provide pastoral care including home and hospital visits, and funerals
