



Youth Director Ministry Description

Objective – Why am I here?

The Youth Director coordinates the Junior and Senior High Ministry by shepherding and discipling students and by equipping and training volunteers.

Strategy- What is needed to accomplish this objective?

- Be in substantive agreement with the reformed theology of Grace & Peace.

- Be intentional in outreach to students, cultivating strong relationships and engaging in evangelism.
- Work diligently to assimilate families and teens into a warm and welcoming environment.
- Strong teaching ability
- Strong interpersonal skills.
- Strong organizational skills.
- Direct the recruitment, training, and development of volunteers.
- Assist in the development of an annual budget for youth ministries and manage spending of the budget.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Tactics- What action needs to be taken to accomplish strategy?

- Prepare and conduct meaningful and purposeful weekly gatherings for youth.
- Communicate regularly with students, parents, and volunteers.
- Embrace and enhance systems to manage tasks.
- Select or develop meaningful and engaging curriculum with emphasis on a thoughtful scope and sequence.
- Create and oversee an effective assimilation pathway/process for connecting new students and their families to the community at Grace & Peace.
- Must possess a strong work ethic and be self-motivated.
- Participate in regular coaching sessions with the Executive Director to develop priorities and leadership acumen.
- The Youth Director will report directly to the Executive Pastor.

Note: Depending on the candidate's qualifications and availability this role may be classified as either a Part-time or a Full-Time position, at the discretion of the Executive Director working in conjunction with the Session of G&P.
