Role

Westminster Presbyterian Church of America is looking for a part-time Youth Ministry Leader. Our mission is to reach people to know Christ, equip believers to obey Christ, and send disciples to advance Christ's kingdom; and we are eager to find someone who can champion that mission with our youth!

Expectations

This role is defined as a part-time non-exempt salary position.

The ideal candidate for this role will commit 24 hours per week to...

- Foster an environment that brings glory to God by ministering the love of Christ to youth across all aspects of their lives.
- Support that environment by serving with a team that will...
 - Organize, proactively communicate about, and lead 6th - 12th grade Biblical education and engagement in the form of (but not limited to)...
 - Sunday school
 - weekly youth group activities
 - bi-weekly youth-oriented small group studies
 - quarterly youth-focused special events
 - Build relationships with the youth, church body, and community so that they feel encouraged to lead, support and/or participate in the youth ministry efforts and activities, such as mentorship, youth praise team, and the like
 - Regularly align plans with the ministry personnel (Senior Pastor & Childrens' Ministry)
 - Equip youth to act as Christ-centered leaders in the midst of our broken world
 - Seek-out opportunities for the youth to serve our local community and beyond through outreach and missions
 - Prepare and manage the youth ministry budget
 - Attend weekly staff meetings (applies to the Youth Ministry Leader)

Accountability

- The Youth Ministry Leader is directly accountable to the Staff Supervisor
- The Staff Supervisor is directly accountable to the Session (Board of Elders).
- The Youth Ministry Leader can contact the Session directly if necessary.

Qualifications

- Required
 - Public profession of Biblical faith
 - Commitment to and lifestyle that demonstrates Biblical values
 - Passion for Biblical teaching and Reformed doctrine
 - Leadership experience
 - Proficiency in building relationships and networking with other ministry leaders
 - Engaging, compassionate, patient personality
 - Proficiency with professional software and communication tools
 - Must obtain all relevant clearances for working with minors in the state of Pennsylvania
- Preferred
 - Youth or children's ministry experience
 - Degree, certification, or relevant experience in Christian Education or Biblical Studies
