History

Good Shepherd began in 1984, when a group of believers wished to form a local church with Reformed teaching and was particularized in the Presbyterian Church in America in 1986. We have a strong history of preaching under four pastors. Originally located in the northern Minneapolis suburbs, our fist building was in Brooklyn Park followed by the move to our current location in Minnetonka in 1999. Consequently, Good Shepherd is a regional rather than neighborhood church. Located in the western suburbs of Minneapolis, members live in twentynine surrounding communities. We are easily accessible, located near the interchange of two major highways about eleven miles west of Minneapolis. Our most recent pastor served for over seven years and left to care for his ailing father. Our congregation grew under his faithful preaching and shepherding. We prayerfully look forward to God providing the man who will lead us during the next chapter in the life of Good Shepherd.

Congregation Details

Our congregation is active and engaged with a high level of participation. Average attendance for Sunday worship services is about 100 for morning and 35 for evening services. Our congregation has a strong core of committed believers, including longtime members as well as newer members. We baptized nine babies last year and rejoiced to have five professions of faith. Good Shepherd has been pleased to have several men train alongside church leadership in recent years for future work in ministry.

Church Life & Hospitality

Because our church family is spread-out geographically, we actively seek ways to encourage hospitality and fellowship. We gather together outside of worship to enjoy monthly fellowship meals, small groups, men's and women's Bible studies, children's song time, prayer meetings, game nights, bridal and baby showers, church work days. We enjoy spending time with one another at church and in our homes.



Missions

We are committed to the work of missions and actively support eight missionary families across the globe through Mission to the World, Wycliffe, and Mission Aviation Fellowship. Most recently, we sent two missionary families from our own congregation. Good Shepherd also supports the local ministries of Together for Good, Hospitality House, and Reformed University Fellowship-University of Minnesota. We seek to grow in our love and engagement with the people of the Twin Cities.
