- Has relevant experience working with youth and families.
- Understands developmental stages of youth as they relate to ministry and Christian discipleship.
- Clear written and verbal communication skills.
- Pastoral skills as it relates to youth and families.
- Organizational skills for developing discipleship plans, event planning, communication, administrative management, budgeting, volunteer/staff background checks, etc.
