Bethel Presbyterian Church, organized in 1764, has a rich history. As one of the oldest churches in the region, and the mother church of six neighboring congregations, the Lord has been faithful in sustaining Bethel over the years. She is uncompromising in her commitment to submitting to the authority of the infallible Word of God, to Christ-centered worship and to the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20).

You'll find Bethel in the rolling countryside of upstate South Carolina's York County. The church is within the unincorporated community of Clover, a suburb of Charlotte, North Carolina, which has a population of around 7,405 and claims the motto of being "*The Town with Love in the Middle.*" One of Clover's major employers is the Clover School District, ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> among 76 districts in South Carolina.

Bethel is thankful to have an active, healthy multi-generational congregation. A week in the life of the congregation at Bethel consists of various active ministries which include: The Lord's Day worship service, Sunday school, Sunday evening Kids Quest (children's catechism), Youth Group, Men and Women's Discipleship Groups, Community Groups, Mentors and Moms, Women's Circles and Men of the Covenant. On an annual basis, the congregation is involved in various fellowship activities which include: Men's trap shoot, family fellowship meals, congregational BBQ, family festivals, senior citizen lunches, ice cream social and youth trips and youth service projects.

Bethel Church is committed to the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ locally, regionally, and internationally. Locally, Bethel supports, Biblical Studies Released Time in the Clover Schools and multiple faith-based upstate South Carolina non-profits. Regionally, Bethel is supporting a church plant in Indian Land, South Carolina and RUF at South Carolina universities. Internationally, the church has long-term relationships with missions and programs in Mexico and Japan.

The church has a strong staff of an Associate Pastor, an Administrative Assistant, a Choir Director and an Intern who serves as the Youth and Family Director. Bethel has consistently taken interns over the years from RTS Charlotte as part of a commitment to develop and send out leaders.
