



## WORSHIP DIRECTOR

Faith Presbyterian Church is four years old and has always desired to be a church that's "timeless," and "dynamic." We believe the combination of these two things will help our church worship God by pointing us away from ourselves and fixing our minds and hearts upon the glory of God. Therefore, FPC is committed to bringing on a man that will help accomplish our goal. We're currently blessed to have a Choir Director (Dr. Henry Duitman), and we'd like to add a Worship Director who's passionate about modern worship (e.g. Sovereign Grace Music, Indelible Grace Music, Robin Mark, Matt Boswell & Matt Papa).

- We believe a Worship Director will help us reach our goal...
  - by leading the integration of modern hymns into our morning and evening services.
  - by leading, planning, and coordinating musicians and singers for our services.
  - by leading our congregational singing with singing and from the piano or guitar.
  - by planning and preparing music for worship services in conjunction with our pastor and choir director.
  - by identifying, training, and equipping new musicians and helping them incorporate their musical gifts into the church.
- Here's a brief description of our current, traditional style of worship.
  - We primarily use the Trinity Psalter Hymnal.
  - We usually sing a modern hymn in both of our services.
  - Our congregational singing is led by the piano or organ and additional instruments.
  - Our choir (20+ members) sings a number of times throughout the year.
- The Worship Director, along with the Pastor and Choir Director, will...
  - organize our services with both traditional and modern styles of music.
  - incorporate modern hymns with accompanying singers (male and female) and instrumentalists (guitar, drums, horns, violins, etc.), while leading in singing and playing the guitar or piano.
  - help us avoid any kind of entertaining style of worship or music that takes away from our goal.

The worship director position is currently a part-time position, offered at \$30,000-35,000. We're hopeful that the Lord will increase our church membership allowing this position to become full-time. If there is a need for extra financial support, we're confident with the many connections our church has in the area that we'd find our Worship Director extra income.
