



How do RUF International and RUF campus ministry compare?

- Both RUF and RUF-I believe that God is at work on university campuses.
- Both RUF and RUF-I represent "the church going to campus."
- Both RUF and RUF-I share the same philosophy of ministry.
- But RUF-I "welcomes the nations" by equipping Christians and local churches to practice biblical hospitality.
- RUF-I campus ministers are ordained pastors, who are called by their Presbyteries, to serve in two roles:
- On-campus: to serve as pastor-chaplains to the foreign-born international students.
- Off-campus: to equip area Christians to welcome internationals (Matthew 25:35) into their lives, homes, and churches.
- **RUF-I campus ministers pursue three missions** in partnership with area churches.
- WELCOME scholars from all nations ministering with deeds of biblical hospitality.
- EXPLORE the Gospel with internationals ministering God's Word with investigative Bible studies.
- EQUIP Christian internationals to become servant-leaders for God's kingdom.
