Duties and Expectations

- Be a Christ-like model for the youth
- Participate in Youth Group, Sunday School, and Youth activities
- Occasionally teach Youth Group on Wednesdays (male interns)
- Assist the Youth Pastor and Youth Ministry Assistant with planning, organizing, and administering weekly youth activities
- Communicate with parents and students about youth events through email, text, and social media
- Assist with Vacation Bible School
- Look for opportunities of outreach, evangelism, service, and discipleship
- Meet with youth in smaller groups and foster relationships
- Oversee the Youth Summer Program when the Youth Pastor is away.

Accountability

 Meet weekly with the Youth Pastor to discuss ministry, how time is spent, personal devotions, and prayer

Time Commitment and Pay

- The youth intern will begin May 27th and end August 4th(approximately 10 weeks).
- The usual days off during the week will usually be Thursday and Saturday, although these are subject to change.
- This is a paid internship. The pay period is once every two weeks.

Expenses

 Interns will be given a ministry expense budget to pay for their own youth activity costs, meals with youth, etc. The intern is expected to be a good steward of this budget and be careful not to overspend.
