NOVEMBER 1999-

A commissioning service was held at First Presbyterian Church of Tuscumbia on November 21 for the Florence church plant.

APRIL 2000 →

The rented facility was quickly outgrown, and on April 9, 2000, the congregation moved to 1626 Florence Boulevard and soon became a particular church.

FALL 1998

Members of the Bible study formed a steering committee to begin the pastoral search and selection, to develop mission and vision statements, and to formulate a budget.

SUMMER 1999

A Campus Outreach team moved to Florence and decided to join the church planting effort while establishing a ministry at UNA.

DECEMBER 1999

On December 5, the first morning worship service was held in a rented facility: Florence Playworld Childcare Center.

Pastor Profile

Redeemer has been faithfully praying for the man whom God has chosen to be our pastor. After careful discussion with the congregation and leadership, we have summarized the strengths and qualities of the man we believe God is calling to be Redeemer's pastor. We are looking for a pastor whose primary gifts are in shepherding the congregation and church leadership and caring for them spiritually.

Ideally, he should be highly relational, with a sincere calling to be invested in the lives of the church members. It is additionally important that he is skilled in organizational leadership, able to establish a vision for the church and empower its membership to carry out that vision. While preferred, we are not prioritizing charisma in the pulpit, however his preaching should be Gospel-centered and applicable to daily life.

In summary, we are looking for a man who is or has:

- A gifted shepherd of both the congregation and leadership
- Highly relational, engaged with the congregation outside of Sunday morning
- Emotionally mature, humble, quick to acknowledge and repent of his own sin
- Personally invested in missions and evangelism, first locally and then abroad
- Passionate about outreach to UNA students and the Shoals community at large
- Prior pastoral experience (preferred)
- Master of Divinity degree
- Ordained, or ordainable, in the PCA

Secondarily, our next pastor should possess the spiritual ability to establish a vision and improve organization through intentional leadership. He should be:

- Strong in organizational and administrative leadership
- Gifted in delegation to empower congregants to execute the Church's vision
- Experienced in personal discipleship and committed to equipping others to also make disciples
- Skilled in Biblical conflict resolution

Finally, he should model a life surrendered to Jesus, preach applicable, Gospel-centered sermons, and be willing to courageously address cultural topics of today.

Shoals at a Glance

Nestled along the banks of the Tennessee River, Florence, Alabama beckons with its unique blend of Southern charm and cultural richness. Immerse yourself in a city where historic architecture meets vibrant creativity, from the iconic W.C. Handy Home to the thriving arts scene at the Kennedy–Douglas Center for the Arts. Enjoy the rhythm of life with live music echoing through the streets and the delectable aroma of local cuisine wafting from charming eateries. In Florence, you'll discover a community that values tradition while embracing innovation – a place where the river flows and the spirit runs deep. Florence, where the soul of the South finds its voice. With a growing population of 41,690 (2022), Florence is described by locals as "Southern living at its best." The picturesque O'Neal bridge and Wilson Dam connect Florence to the other three cities composing the area known as "The Shoals"—Muscle Shoals, Sheffield, and Tuscumbia. The area, with a combined population of 148,779 (2020 Census) claims musical, historical, and even architectural pride by holding two gold record producing recording studios (Muscle Shoals Sound Studio and Fame Recording Studios), the birthplace of Helen Keller, and an original Frank Lloyd Wright home (the only one in Alabama).

Recently cited as one of the most affordable urban areas in the US to live, Florence housing is affordable, and both public and private schools are highly regarded. 2 Alabama cities make new top 10 list of least expensive urban areas in U.S. Florence is also home to The University of North Alabama—the state's oldest public university, which has an enrollment of 10,600 students from 50 countries. UNA has recently experienced its 16th consecutive semester of increased enrollment, and for the last several years has been been noted as the fastest growing university in Alabama. It also boasts the title as the only university in the country with a live lion mascot ("Leo") that resides on campus.

Historic downtown Florence is vibrant and welcoming—a place where you're likely to run into a friend. Home to local restaurants (such as that of Award–Winning Chef John Currence), boutique hotels, coffee shops, and retail stores including famed fashion designer Billy Reid's flagship store. It provides entertainment for locals at the historic Shoals Theatre and also hosts the favored First Fridays events, as well as other seasonal festivals.





Situated along the Tennessee River, the area is said to be a "treasure chest" of outdoor recreational opportunities. There are miles of riverside hiking and biking trails, a multitude of parks, and world-class golf at a local Robert Trent Jones golf course. If water activates are desired, your opportunities abound here! Several annual bass fishing tournaments are held on Wilson Lake, and in addition, area waterways offer opportunity for boating, skiing, and fishing. Consider kayaking along Cypress Creek if a slower pace is desired.


Florence is conveniently located within a two-hour radius of several major cities: Huntsville, Birmingham, Nashville, and Memphis.
