
SENIOR PASTOR PACKET


WHO WE ARE

AS A CONGREGATION

PARISH CHURCH BEGAN AS A CHURCH PLANT NINE YEARS AGO AND GREW FROM MEETING IN A RENTED EVENT HALL TO PURCHASING OUR OWN BUILDING AND BECOMING PARTICULARIZED IN 2021. MANY OF OUR MEMBERS AND REGULAR ATTENDEES COME FROM NON-PRESBYTERIAN BACKGROUNDS. SOME EXPERIENCED HURT IN THEIR PREVIOUS CHURCHES AND FOUND HEALING AT PARISH THROUGH THE TEACHING OF REFORMED THEOLOGY AND GRACE FOUND IN THE GOSPEL MESSAGE. SOME OF OUR CONGREGANTS WERE PART OF THE PCA FOR MOST OF THEIR LIVES OR CAME TO US FROM THE PCUSA.

OUR CONGREGATION IS A BROAD SWATH OF SOCIETY REPRESENTED BY DIVERSE ETHNICITIES, CULTURES, AND AGES. FROM CHILDREN TO RETIREES, COLLEGE STUDENTS TO WORKING PROFESSIONALS AND LABORERS, OUR MEMBERS AND ATTENDEES WORSHIP AND FELLOWSHIP TOGETHER. THE AVERAGE SUNDAY ATTENDANCE IS 94. MOST ARE REGULAR ATTENDERS OR MEMBERS BUT THERE ARE ALWAYS NEW, INTERESTED FACES IN THE CROWD SEEKING THE LORD AND FELLOWSHIP.


Community


CAJUN FOOD
