Director of Youth (Middle - High School-aged) Ministries at Christ Church, Presbyterian, at Evans, Georgia

Responsibilities

In coordination with Christ Church (CC) Staff, provide biblical, pastoral leadership for CC youth and their families in the following ways:

- Minister to the Middle School and High School-aged youth at Christ Church, weekly teaching the Youth Sunday School Class and Wednesday Evening Youth Bible Study, along with other possible appointments appropriate to coordinated development goals;
- Maintain a discipline of prayer for youth and their families;
- Exemplify, teach, and foster spiritual maturity as Jesus did;
- Teach the historical facts, doctrines, covenants, moral law, logic, literatures, and Spirit of the Bible, in accord with the Westminster Standards;
- Develop relationships with parents of youth to spiritually strengthen families, develop trust, and address parental rules and concerns;
- Recruit and train Youth and young adults to join and voluntarily serve the church, in general and in official roles;
- Support, encourage, and exemplify discipleship in every context through attending individual and collective student events outside the CC campus;
- Plan, promote, and lead special activities and retreats, fostering a culture of Youth participation in worship, fellowship, and advancing the Kingdom of God on mission with the congregation;
 - Youth or Congregational Retreats and Camps (1 Summer, 1 Winter);
 - Monthly:
 - Youth or Congregational Service Projects to the public; OR
 - Youth or Congregational Outreach/Mission; OR
 - Youth or Congregational recreational outing;
- Develop and maintain open communication and cooperative ministries with other churches inside and outside the Savannah River Presbytery;
- Communicate to parents, youth, staff, committees, and coordinate funds, purchases, calendars, events, etc;
- Meet regularly with the Senior Pastor and Directors of Children's Ministries and Young Adult's Ministries to implement unity of vision and direction;
- Attend all regular and appropriate committee, staff, and Session meetings;
- Lead or assist with recreation and games during weekly Youth meetings.

Required Traits

- ❖ Commitment as a growing disciple of Jesus Christ and adherence to PCA and CC standards;
- ❖ Commitment to the training and equipping of God's people for the work of ministry (Ephesians 4:11-14);
- ❖ Ability and devotion to teaching youth and young adults;
- ❖ Commitment to working as part of a team to accomplish Session goals;
- ❖ Commitment to pray for the ministry at Christ Church, Presbyterian and to study Scripture in search of God's will for this ministry;
- ❖ Commitment in life to maintaining integrity and pursuing reconciliation;
- ❖ Make constant and routine all protocols to honor the name of Jesus and His Bride, the Church, allowing no occasion for shame;
- ❖ Discernment, sensitivity, and ability to maintain confidentiality;
- ❖ Organization, communication, management, and timeliness;
- ❖ Comfortable and proficient in use of technology as a tool for ministry.

Accountability

The Director of Youth Ministries is accountable to the Session and the Senior Pastor. The Session and Senior Pastor will provide this position with evaluative feedback at regular intervals as determined by the Administrative Committee.
