**Role Description**

- Twice per week in-depth teaching to (largely) college-bound middle/high school students.
- Oversee middle/high school Sunday School and Wednesday night youth group.
- Oversee annual events for middle/high school students (retreats, mission trip, etc.).
- Recruit and disciple volunteers for middle/high school ministry.
- Shepherding and family care of the congregation, particularly families of youth.
- Leading congregation in fellowship with God in morning and evening worship rotation.
- Senior care and visitation along with entire pastoral staff.
- Preach from God's Word at least six (6) times annually at evening services.
- Provide general pastoral leadership in various areas designated by the Session, Senior, or Associate Pastor, assisting with organizational pastoral needs as they arise.

- Master of Divinity degree.
- Ordained or immediately ordainable in the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA).
- Personal characteristics consistent with Christian maturity.
- Strong pastoral instincts and natural disposition to provide care for people.
- Demonstrated ability to preach with a strong advocacy in the ministry of the Word.
- Enjoys and supports Westminster's style of worship.
- Faithful devotion to the ordinary means of grace.
