**Purpose:** The purpose of the pastoral internship at Christ Presbyterian Church is twofold. It shall:

1. Serve the needs of the intern for an effective, meaningful internship experience that will aid in clarifying God's call upon the intern to pursue ministry and will meet the requirements of the intern's educational institution for such an experience.
2. Serve the needs of Christ Presbyterian Church for assistance in ministry in practical and productive ways.

**Duties for the Pastoral Internship:**

- The role of an intern will evolve over time and will be developed by the Senior Pastor. He will consider the intern's seminary course load and assign responsibilities and tasks that fit the intern's capacities for each semester.

**Compensation and Benefits**

- Salary to be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
- CPC will provide the intern with a full scholarship to RTS Houston plus a book allowance.

**Qualifications**

- Education / Experience: college graduate; pursuing an MDiv seminary degree or desires to pursue an MDiv seminary degree; willingness to be ordained in the PCA; previous paid or volunteer ministry experience. For the right candidate, CPC will pay for RTS Houston Seminary tuition and books to complete an MDiv degree in addition to being paid a full-time salary.
- Knowledge: Understanding of Biblical and reformed theology
