QUALIFICATIONS

• Demonstrates a deep Gospel-humility, while also being confident and passionate about accomplishing great Kingdom purposes in reliance on the power of the Holy Spirit.

- Affirms core beliefs and doctrinal standards of CFC, and models the life of a disciple who embodies CFC's Purpose, Vision, and Values.
- Exhibits leadership with strong interpersonal skills that can adapt to various personalities and contexts.
- Evidences Godly character in personal life, family relationships and ministry and a demonstrated desire to grow both spiritually and professionally.
- Remains free from addictions.
- For part-time Bachelor's degree and current enrollment in or completion of theological training at an accredited seminary with a commitment to Reformed teaching.
 For full time - College and seminary degree; experience preferred; ordained or ordainable in the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA).

RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES

For part-time, responsibilities will include Youth Ministry only.

Youth Ministry

- Lead the worship service for Covenant Youth Juniors (CFC's middle school ministry);
- Hold regular visitations with students of Covenant Youth Juniors:
- Pray for the students and volunteers of Covenant Youth Juniors;
- Help lead weekly Friday Night Fellowship;
- Provide counseling for students and parents as needed;
- Plan fellowship outings and outreach opportunities throughout the year (at least one per quarter).
- Help organize and lead two retreats a year (summer and winter);
- Help organize and lead yearly summer mission trips to Red Lake (or other locations);
- Perform other duties as assigned by Senior Pastor.

Children's Ministry

- Provide leadership, training, support and oversight for the Children's Ministry;
- · Help recruit teachers and volunteers as needed; and
- Oversee special events (Hallelujah Night, Christmas presentations, programming at All-church retreat, etc.).



College/Young Adult Ministry

- Help lead college/young adult community group;
- Develop and lead programs, Bible studies, activities for college students and young adults:
- Provide pastoral care to college students (both local and out of state).

Other

- Preach and lead worship as requested by the Senior Pastor to the adult congregation;
- Attend and help lead monthly Saturday morning prayers;
- Help with special events as needed;
- Help with summer programming (e.g., Vision School) as needed; and
- Presbytery attendance and involvement in committees.

ABOUT COVENANT FELLOWSHIP CHURCH

CFC is a Gospel-centered, loving community aspiring to joyful obedience to the Lord shown in gospel-advancing acts of faith. As disciple-making disciples, we aim to participate actively in the Kingdom-building process by winning people to Christ and growing them up in Christ, to live out our vision to see lives transformed by the gospel of Jesus Christ. CFC is a member of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA).
