Our History

Faith Reformed Church began as a Bible Study in 1976, meeting in a Howard Johnson's motel on Peach Street. Most of the members had been members of the United Presbyterian Church in the USA (now the PCUSA), but they desired to be in a Bible-believing Presbyterian church.

The church was organized in 1980, with Paul Doriani as the organizing pastor. We purchased our building in 1981 from a Lutheran congregation. Pastor Doriani left in December 1984.

Pastor H. Leon Ben-Ezra was installed in October 1985.

The church grew slowly in the 1980's and early 1990's. In 1994, a small group from Faith Reformed Church, led by Pastor Jerry Knight, began a Bible Study in downtown Erie. This group eventually formed West Erie Bible Presbyterian Church (now West Erie Presbyterian Church), which became a particular church in 1999. Jerry Knight eventually accepted a call as a professor at African Bible University in Uganda, and we supported him as a missionary for many years, until his retirement.

After 33 years of service, Pastor Ben-Ezra retired in August of 2019. In early 2020, we extended a call to David Hills, a recent seminary graduate preparing for ordination after a military and consulting career. Before he could be examined by Presbytery and ordained, the COVID-19 pandemic broke out, and we were without a pastor going into this period. We used Zoom for worship services from March to May of 2020, but we secured regular in-person pulpit supply and we resumed in-person worship in June of 2020. Pastor Hills was able to join us, first as Student Supply in August of 2020. He was ordained in early 2021. He has announced his retirement in 2026. We now seek a new pastor to lead us going forward.

About Erie, PA

Faith Reformed Church is located in Harborcreek township, a suburb of Erie, PA, minutes away from the heart of the city. Erie is a mid-sized city on Lake Erie's Presque Isle Bay and is a two-hour drive from Cleveland, Pittsburgh, and Buffalo. The economic base includes industrial plants, with a specialization in plastics, and a service sector which includes medical, insurance, and tourism. Erie is home to one Fortune 500 company, Erie Insurance Group, which employs more than 3,400 workers in the local area.

The region experiences all four seasons distinctly and offers many opportunities for seasonal outdoor recreation at places like nearby Presque Isle State Park with its enticing seven miles of beaches and recreation, and the Peek 'n Peak Ski Resort which offers year-round activities. There are a number of cultural, historical, and sports resources, as well, including the Warner Theatre as Erie's own Cultural Center with the Erie Philharmonic, Lake Erie Ballet, and the Erie Broadway series.

Erie has a modest cost of living, affordable housing, an international airport, and is home to two nationally ranked hospitals which are also affiliated with larger health system networks. The county is home to six colleges/universities, one of which is within a few minutes of FRC, and another is the Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine (LECOM), the largest medical school in the country. Our congregation values sound, Biblical doctrine, vibrant fellowship, and thoughtful, liturgical worship, reflected, in part, by our practice of weekly communion and use of creeds. The congregants believe that first and foremost, the pastor should faithfully and with authority proclaim the Word of God in the power of the Holy Spirit. We fully support our pastor placing sermon preparation at the top of his priorities.


Secondly, FRC needs a teacher, shepherd, and leader. We envision that alongside preaching, he would partner with the ruling elders to disciple the flock through small group Bible studies, offer Biblical guidance and counseling, and develop and raise up leaders from within the congregation. Also, we value a pastor who leads by example—who models humility and a willingness to serve wherever there is a need.

Thirdly, FRC believes that fellowship is an important aspect of church life. To support this, we have monthly luncheons after worship and various biweekly, small group Bible studies in our homes and at the nearby college. Our congregation holds hospitality in high regard and feels the pastor should himself enjoy fellowship with the brothers and sisters at FRC. We hope he would welcome congregants into his home and/or would feel comfortable visiting the homes of congregants. If saints are struggling and unable to fellowship at the church, we desire that our shepherd would reach out to those individuals through home and/or hospital visitation.

Lastly, our congregation has a growing heart for missions, evangelism, and outreach, both locally and abroad. We are a small church with widely scattered members, and although we come from different communities, we all want to improve our witness to our respective communities by meeting their spiritual and physical needs. We need a pastor who will guide us through this process, nurture, and encourage us in these things, as we would like to grow in this.

Compensation

FRC will offer a total package (i.e. salary, housing allowance, retirement, and benefits) of \$75,000 - \$85,000 to our new pastor. In addition, a one-time relocation reimbursement up to a maximum of \$10,000 will be provided upon substantiation of expenses. The Terms of Call will also include four weeks of paid annual vacation and two weeks of study leave.
