We are searching for a new solo pastor due to the loss of our beloved Pastor, Shelby Moon, who on August 28, 2025 went home to the Lord after an eight-year battle with leukemia. He was loved, not only by the WPC church body, but by the entire community and is greatly missed. He had faithfully pastored Westminster for over 13 years.

Westminster Presbyterian Church (WPC) is a member of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA), Rio Grande Presbytery. It is a multigenerational congregation of believers committed to the faithful preaching and teaching of reformed biblical truth. We are committed to the Westminster standards and follow the regulatory principles for our worship liturgy. WPC is located in Alamogordo, NM at the base of the Sacramento Mountains in Southeastern New Mexico and overlooking the Tularosa Basin, WPC is about 10 miles from Holloman AFB and near the entrance to White Sands Missile Range.

The mission of WPC is to glorify the Triune God and enjoy Him forever and to proclaim the Gospel from the reformed, God-centered worldview, leading the unsaved to Christ, and nurturing believers in the Faith as members of the church.

We are looking for a pastor who would share Our Vision of encouraging spiritual growth, growing our numbers and be an influence in the community to expand our ministry and to provide a light in the world as our Lord leads and permits.

Westminster Presbyterian Church was founded in the fall of 1964 and was based on the principle that the Bible is the infallible, inerrant Word of God. After some time meeting in the homes of members, the church purchased a building from a local church that had outgrown the



building. The church still resides there, but has expanded and remodeled multiple times during these 60 years.

Much of the membership of the church is provided by a continual rotation of families moving in and out of the area due to the large military presence. With the military presence in the area, a primary target of ministry is to that demographic - not just military members and families who are stationed in the Alamogordo area, but also members who have chosen to remain in the area after leaving the military or retiring. There is a good percentage of retired individuals in the church.

Although there are significant variations in attendance over time due to the military presence, the church has maintained a stable

financial situation with funds available in reserve for use during down times.

The means of or reaching these target areas of ministry are largely focused on Bible Studies, and as the group of children is increasing in our church, an emphasis on children and youth outreach is hopefully on our horizon. Up until the death of our pastor we had a vibrant "inquirers" class for new members and anyone else who wanted to know more about the church beliefs and activities. Cultural turmoil in our country has opened up a significant need for ministry of apologetics in almost all Christian circles and secular circles as well. Our church is no exception. Being a Christian is not a "given" today and the need for all of us to be able to defend our faith is not only growing but is of greater necessity than ever.
