DIRECT REPORT: Pastor of Discipleship

GOAL OF THIS POSITION: To lead the Youth and Children's Ministries by teaching God's Word and the gospel of Jesus Christ, fostering a love for God, and growth in discipleship and community within the Youth and Children of Hope Presbyterian Church

DESCRIPTION OF PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Youth Ministry (30 hours per week)

- Work with the Pastor of Discipleship to develop and implement vision and goals for the Youth Ministry
- Overseeing and supervising the youth budget each year in coordination with the Pastor of Discipleship
- Recruiting, leading, and equipping youth volunteers and staff
- Leading Youth Small Group(s) in the study of the Scriptures
- Preparing and teaching Youth Sunday School and Youth Group
- Organizing and executing regular events and retreats throughout the year for youth to connect and grow together
- Planning and leading regular local and international missions opportunities for youth
- Discipling the youth relationally through one-on-one and group contacts
- Love and serve the parents of the students through effective communication and providing resources and supporting in raising teenagers.

Children's Ministry (8-10 hours per week)

- Coordinate and oversee Sunday morning ministries which include: Nursery, Children's Church, Sunday School in both the Nursery and PreK-5th grade, and providing worship bags for young children to use during the worship services
- Oversee Nursery Coordinator
- Maintain and nurture volunteer relationships and recruit new volunteers as needed
- Organize special events for the Children's Ministry throughout the year
