About Redeemer



Redeemer Church began as a Bible study in a neighborhood home in the fall of 1995. Since then, God has faithfully sustained Redeemer as a church that seeks to glorify God in all that we do and proclaim the gospel to our community and the world.

We are Reformed, proclaiming salvation through faith in Jesus, holding to biblical truths emphasized in the Protestant Reformation and summarized in the Westminster Confession and Catechisms. We stand in the historic Christian tradition and affirm the core teachings recovered in the Reformation—especially the authority of Scripture and the biblical gospel.

We hold to the five solas (Scripture Alone, Grace Alone, Faith Alone, Christ Alone, God's Glory Alone) and the Doctrines of Grace (TULIP), which summarize God's saving work from beginning to end.

We use the Westminster standards as faithful summaries of biblical teaching. These documents guide us, but Scripture remains our final authority.

Redeemer has had two Senior Pastors in its 30-year history and currently meets in the Community Room at the Parker Task Force each Sunday at 10:30 AM.

Redeemer’s attendance has been as high as 125-150, and prior to the 2020 pandemic, Redeemer’s average attendance was 90. As with so many churches around the world, the pandemic forced Redeemer to relocate four times in two years, and was unable to retain a number of attendees who relocated or left the church during this time.

God has continued to provide for Redeemer in countless ways since 2020, most recently providing a meeting space for us to meet and grow into at no cost, and we have reallocated much of that expense to boost our savings and invest in a social media growth campaign.

While based in Parker, Redeemer congregants live in surrounding areas like Aurora, Elizabeth, and Franktown.

Our Community



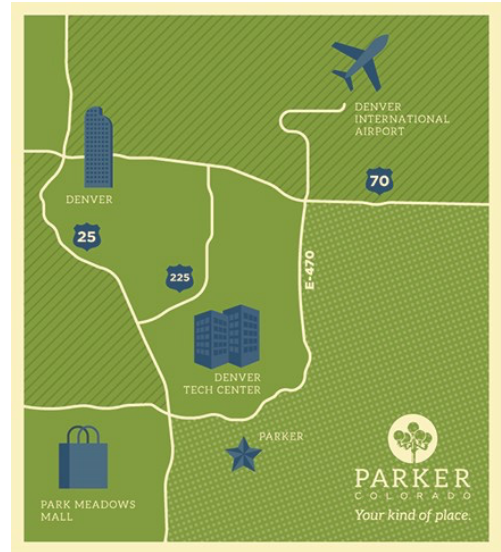
Parker, located in Douglas County with easy access to the Denver metropolitan area, is known for its unique Western-Victorian downtown and its hometown feel.

Qualifications

The Senior Pastor is a man ordained (or easily ordainable) to ministry by the Presbyterian Church In America (PCA), as called by the congregation and approved by the Rocky Mountain Presbytery in accordance with the PCA Book of Church Order (BCO).

We seek a Pastor with a deep Reformed conviction - rooted in the sovereignty of God, the authority of Scripture, and the rich heritage of the Westminster Standards. He is eager to shepherd a congregation faithfully, committed to growth through gospel advancement in an ungodly culture, the ordinary means of grace, and covenantal discipleship.

- Meets the Teaching Elder qualifications
(1 Timothy 3:1-13, Titus 1: 6-9, and 1 Peter 5: 1-4)
- Lives a godly life according to Scripture
(Matt. 20:25-28, 1 Cor. 6:9-11, Gal. 5:13-26, and Eph. 5:1-14)
- Demonstrated ability to exposit the Bible (Old and New Testaments) in a clear, compelling, and Christocentric way that engages both the mind and the heart while applying the Word of God to the time and circumstances in which God has placed us
- Demonstrated ability to strategize, lead, and execute well the development of leaders and ministry growth
- Demonstrated ability to promote fellowship within the Church through shepherding, care, counseling, and hospitality
- Demonstrated ability to gather and minister to those outside the church through personal engagement and outreach events
- Demonstrated ability to walk with congregants through the joys and trials of life
- Humbly relies on a deep prayer life for strength in the ministry



Senior Pastor Job Description

Duties & Responsibilities

With a clear calling from the Lord to advance His Kingdom in Parker, Colorado, the primary charge of this pastoral ministry is to lead Redeemer Presbyterian Church in our vision of becoming a thriving congregation of 125-150 members again. This vision will be pursued through fervent prayer, faithful exposition of Scripture, intentional discipleship, and gospel-centered outreach, trusting in the sovereign power of the Holy Spirit to add to the church daily those who are being saved.

In service of this calling, the Senior Pastor will:

- Be passionate with a holy ambition to see Christ's Kingdom expand in our community
- Be expected to joyfully preach and administer the sacraments at least 43 Sundays per year and find qualified replacements for remaining weeks
- Be skilled in people gathering, church marketing, and growing a congregation
- Love accountability, systems of organization, administration, and be results oriented
- Be a proactive leader in overseeing, developing, and managing volunteer leaders
- Collaborate with the Session and staff to prayerfully discern, establish, and execute a biblical vision and strategy for growing Redeemer (rooted in Reformed theology, covenantal community, and the Great Commission)
- Intentionally identify, recruit, train, and equip gifted members of the congregation for key leadership roles, raising up future leaders and strengthening the overall maturity of the body
- Develop a robust and compassionate diaconate
- Participate in further developing education and ministry to the children and youth of Redeemer
- Cultivate meaningful relationships with like-minded ministry leaders in the Parker community and participate in the minimally required meetings of the Rocky Mountain Presbytery
- Develop relationships by living in and engaging with the Parker community
- Officiate weddings, funerals, and baptisms in order to minister the comfort of the gospel in life's defining moments

*** As a solo pastor, the qualified applicant will be expected to successfully perform the above duties in partnership with volunteers in the church.*
