



EXPERIENCED TRANSITIONAL ASSISTANT PASTOR POSITION

An experienced transitional assistant pastor is being sought by the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Bowie "RPCB" (PCA)

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT:

RPCB is seeking a transitional assistant pastor to support its current pastor. Our church was formed as a congregation in the PCA (Presbyterian Church in America) in 1985 and meets for morning and evening worship services, with a hymn sing in the evening one Sunday per month. We have been blessed with a long history of pastoral continuity, our current senior pastor having served us since 2007, succeeding our founding pastor, who served from 1985 until his retirement in 2022. The current senior pastor has recently accepted a new call as a seminary professor at Westminster Philadelphia and is resigning effective June 30. Effective July 1, our current associate pastor will take on the primary responsibilities of the senior pastor. The church is seeking an experienced pastor to support him during the transition period (12-24 months) to follow.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Reformed theological alignment, including Christ-centered preaching
- Ordained in a reformed denomination and upholds the Westminster standards
- Willing and able to preach with some regularity
- Minimum of 10-years pastoral/ministerial experience
- Available for this position for at least the next 12 months
- Minimum of 20 hours per week and most Sundays (2 out of 3)
- Significant experience in congregational care and counseling
- Sees himself as a "contributor" to our ministry growth, not a "director"

PREFERENCES:

- Start date no later than September 1 (position is available as of July 1)
- Local Baltimore/Washington DC region resident
- Available 32-40 hours a week and almost every Sunday
- Connections in the PCA to help RPCB find a long-term assistant pastor

COMPENSATION PACKAGE:

- \$110,000 for full-time position
- Adjusted based on hours available for ministry
