Purpose of Position

Lead and direct pastoral care efforts at King's Cross Church in Oklahoma City, in alignment with our mission to "worship God together and give witness to his love for us in Christ." This position will involve the regular care of members and the equipping of lay leaders to extend King's Cross's care. The position will also assist with adult discipleship and education efforts, particularly in the men's ministry.

Pastoral Care

- Offers care, counseling, discipleship, and visitation in coordination with senior pastor
- Outreach and evangelism to community
- Assists in welcoming and assimilating visitors and new members
- Assists in equipping officers and lay leaders for congregational care
- Assists in care of staff
- Prays consistently, both individually and as staff

Preaching, Teaching, and Worship

- Assists senior pastor in the ministry of Word and sacrament as directed by senior pastor
- Assists in teaching adult Sunday school classes
- Officiates weddings and funerals as needed

Programmatic Leadership

- Directs men's ministry
- Directs Community Builder (small group) ministry and equips its leaders
- Assists pastor in directing overall scope and sequence for King's Cross's adult education
- Organizes and assists in planning retreats and Bible studies

General Responsibilities

- Meets regularly with senior pastor and officers as member of leadership team
- Attends session meetings
- Attends and participates in presbytery meetings and serves on presbytery committee(s)
- Oversees and directs adult educational efforts at King's Cross, especially the men's ministry
- Serves on committees as needed
- Proactively considers new or neglected areas of need and with the senior pastor develops ways of meeting those needs

- Lively, growing faith in Jesus Christ with a humble commitment to Reformed theology as summarized in the Westminster standards.
- Character qualifications outline in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, and 1 Peter 5:1-4
- Seminary degree (master's level) and ordained (or ordainable) as a Teaching Elder in the Presbyterian Church in America
- Ability to follow and lead; works well with others
