Purpose. Seeking a woman to serve full-time with the CTK Youth Ministry while providing a context for her to receive mentorship and training for ministry.

Vision for ministry. *Gospel-Driven*: centering all ministry on the grace of Jesus Christ; *Reformed*: embracing the doctrine of the Westminster Standards; *Relational*: pursuing and loving our students and families; *Integrated*: wholistic discipleship that includes our youth in the full mission of the church.

Candidate Profile. The intern will be a gospel-centered woman who exhibits the following qualities:

- Profession of faith in Jesus Christ and ongoing obedience to Him as guided by Scripture.
- Committed theologically to the Reformed doctrine as described in the Westminster Standards.
- Active participant in the life of the church and affirms the CTK Youth ministry vision.
- Motivated leader who relates well with 6th-12th grade girls.
- Organized team player, good communicator, and effective teacher.

Primary ministry responsibilities.

- Full-time (40 hours/week)
- 2-year minimum commitment
- Reports to the CTK Youth Pastor
- CTK Roles & Responsibilities
 - o Pursue one-on-one relationships to disciple female students
 - o Help lead and oversee girls' small groups and Bible studies
 - o Assist with Sunday-evening Youth Group
 - Assist in teaching Sunday school
 - Assist with youth events throughout the year (conferences/retreats, service projects, day trips, parent meetings, etc.).
 - o Communicate with parents on ministry matters pertaining to female students.
 - o Help recruit, equip, and supervise female volunteers to serve in the Youth Ministry.
 - Other duties as assigned by the Youth Pastor.
- RYM Roles & Responsibilities
 - o Church Internship Program (CIP) Cohort Retreats (x2; late-Aug & late-May)
 - o CIP Cohort Zoom meetings (2/month; Sep-May)
 - One-to-one Zoom coaching (1 call/month; Sep-May)
 - o Completion of CIP Study Program (approx. 10 hours/week)
 - o Attend RYM Youth Leader Training conference (1 week/year)
