Desired Qualifications

- For consideration of the Worship Pastor position (not the Worship Director), the candidate must be ordained, qualified for ordination, or pursuing qualifications for ordination in the Presbyterian Church of America to serve as an Assistant Pastor at Tabernacle.
- For consideration of the Worship Director position (not the Worship Pastor), the candidate must have an evangelical and reformed faith consistent with the overall confession, mission and vision of Tabernacle.
- Experience and gifting in rehearsing, arranging, reading music and leading traditional and contemporary music styles for corporate worship (Bachelor's degree in music or equivalent preferred).
- Organizational and administrative skills and abilities are required.

Overall Responsibilities

- Promote, develop and lead a Gospel-centered approach to corporate worship.
- Implement the overall vision of the church in and through the worship/music ministry.
- Provide musical and spiritual leadership and training for a multi-generational worship team.
- Provide music input/leadership in corporate worship services on Sunday and for other services throughout the year as needed.
- Provide oversight and guidance for developing other worship leaders in the church.
- Oversee the Audio/Visual Team and recommend maintenance and purchase of A/V equipment as needed.

Regular Duties

- Coordinate with the pastoral team in planning corporate worship services.
- Conduct rehearsals as necessary for the worship team.
- Plan and lead corporate worship as appropriate and necessary.
- Oversee and expand music library; stay current with new musical offerings appropriate for Tabernacle's corporate worship.
- Communicate/coordinate schedules and reminders for the worship team.

Additional Responsibilities

The primary emphasis for the position is shepherding the worship ministry of Tabernacle PCA. This can be done on a part-time basis. If the candidate desires a full-time position, a secondary ministry emphasis will be in another area of ministry designed to fit the ministry skills and passions of the candidate. Options include (but are not limited to):

- Worship and Church Planting Apprentice
- Worship and Youth Ministry
- Worship and Children's Ministry
- Worship and Congregational Care

The secondary emphasis of the full-time position will depend on the candidate's additional qualifications. For instance, the Church Planting Apprenticeship will require the candidate have a passion for church planting. A candidate interested in Youth Ministry should possess a passion for the next generation. Our goal is to find the right person instead of prioritizing a specific secondary emphasis.
