About the Role

We are seeking a dynamic, fun, engaging, and Christ-following children's ministry director for kids from birth to 5th grade! This is an exciting opportunity for a motivated individual to join our community and have a hand in shaping our children's ministry. Our goal is to raise children who love and follow Christ and we invite the children's ministry director to come alongside parents in creating a safe place for children to learn about Jesus through bible study, relationships, and special events.

This is a part-time salaried position (10–15 hours/week). The desired start date would be January 2022 and depending on date of hire, the children's ministry director will help plan and prepare for our official church launch on Easter 2022 with the goal that we are able to kick off an engaging and exciting Sunday children's ministry program on our start date. Leading up to the Easter service, the children's ministry director will have the opportunity to begin to engage the church's children at the church plant leadership meetings, monthly church services, and community events. Aside from Sunday services and the staff meetings, the director would have flexibility in when they executed their responsibilities.

Responsibilities:

- Create a fun, welcoming environment for kids to learn about and follow Jesus.
- Coordinate Sunday worship for the youth from birth-5th grade: bible study and curriculum (musical inclination added bonus). Depending on interest level of applicant, may be able to play a role in selecting curriculum
- Recruit, equip, and provide care for children's ministry volunteers.
- Partner with parents through regular check-ins and communication regarding children's Sunday ministry.
- Attend weekly staff meetings and collaborate with staff on church-wide events.
- Assist in planning and organizing volunteers for family-specific events.
- Maintain high standards of child-related safety and security.

- BA/BS (education, early childhood development a plus) or current ministry graduate student, or a high school education with significant children's ministry experience
- Over 1 year of experience working with children (may be volunteer experience if significant)
- COVID vaccination required

Personal Characteristics

- A healthy, growing relationship with Jesus Christ, a current church member in good standing who is able to endorse a reformed theology and affirm the tenants of the PCA denomination (including infant baptism).
- Creative, problem solver, hard-working, and loves to have fun who has a
 positive attitude and winsome personality.
- Enjoys creating fun and engaging environments and experiences for kids.
- Able to engage with kids, partner with parents, and lead teams.

- An excellent communicator and able to deliver relevant, Biblical messages to children from toddlers to elementary-aged children.
- A self-starter who also thrives in collaboration with others on a team.
- Humble, teachable, and committed to a growth mindset.
- Passionate about serving and reaching unchurched people (& kids!) with the good news of Jesus.
