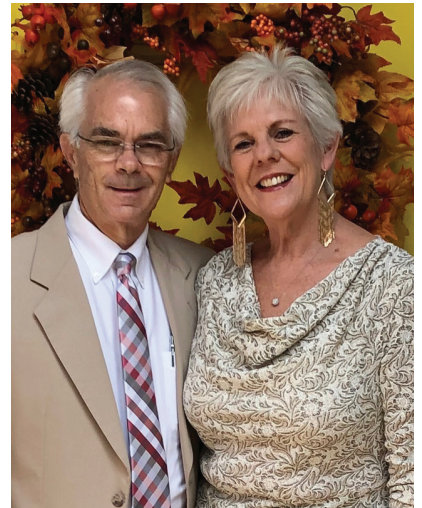


A Letter from Redeemer's Founding Pastor

Location has been a leading value to me in the four locations in which I served (South Carolina, Kansas, Florida, and Colorado). Location is what drew us here to Colorado. The mountains, sunshine, low humidity, and year round recreation is a great place to raise a family. And we did!

My wife and I are from the midwest and the climate here can't be beat. We love the culture of Denver. It's artistic, musical, cosmopolitan, open, and has all four major sports! We love living here and call it our home. I'm sure the next pastor will too!

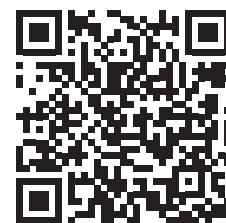

Senior Pastor Job Description

Compensation

The compensation package includes salary, housing allowance, benefits and ministerial expense reimbursement. The total amount of the compensation package will be negotiable and consideration will be given to the cost-of-living in the Town of Parker and surrounding communities.

Qualifications

- The Senior Pastor is a man ordained (or easily ordainable) to ministry by the Presbyterian Church In America (PCA), as called by the congregation and approved by the Rocky Mountain Presbytery in accordance with the PCA Book of Church Order (BCO).
- Demonstrated history of meeting the Teaching Elder qualifications as stated in 1 Timothy 3:1-13, 1 Peter 5: 1-4 and Titus 1: 6-9.
- Lives a godly life according to Scripture (Gal. 5:13-26, 1 Cor. 6:9-11, Matt. 20:25-28, and Eph. 5:1-14).
- Demonstrated ability to teach and preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ from all of Scripture, showing the relevance to those inside and outside the Body of Christ.
- Demonstrated ability to lead from the top level and disciple others within the Church to become thriving members of the Body of Christ.
- Promotes fellowship within the Church through different activities and outreach events.
- Humbly relies on a deep prayer life for strength in the ministry.
- Demonstrated ability to walk with congregants through the joys and travails of life.
- Demonstrated ability to gather and minister to those outside the Church.

Duties & Responsibilities

- As a teaching elder and fellow member of the Session, work with ruling elders to set the vision, strategy and execution of Redeemer's ministry
- Organize structure of weekly worship services
- Preach the Gospel at weekly worship services
- Organize adult Sunday School with qualified instructors from within the congregation
- Oversee the various Redeemer ministries and ensure they are properly equipped
- Train, disciple and equip congregants into key ministry positions
- Ensure robust connection with and participation in the Rocky Mountain Presbytery
- Provide counsel and visitation
- Officiate weddings, funerals, baptisms, etc. as needed

*** As a solo pastor, the qualified applicant will be expected to successfully perform the above duties in partnership with volunteers in the church.*
