Major Duties & Responsibilities:

Redeemer Montclair Student Ministry seeks to invite 6th-12th grade students to be life-long disciples of Jesus Christ who:

- Practice **Discipleship**,
- And engage in God's **Mission**.

How the Student Ministry Intern will implement this ministry vision:

- Prepare and lead weekly meetings, divided between middle school and high school students, on Sundays from 11:30am-12:30pm where students build friendships by gathering around food and games and practice discipleship by hearing teaching from God's word and breaking into small groups to understand how to apply it to their lives.
- Organize and lead monthly special activities that include fellowship events (i.e. game nights, rock climbing, talent show, etc.) and service opportunities (Toni's Soup Kitchen, Earth Day Park Cleanup, caroling for seniors, etc.).
- Recruit and lead our students to attend the annual winter presbytery retreat, The Great Escape, during the last weekend in January.
- Recruit, equip, and lead adult volunteers and parents in carrying out the ministry vision.
- Personally contact students at informal events (such as school sports, plays, or community events).
- Nurture Christ-centered friendships between students through small group discipleship and other informal relational opportunities.
