



Job Title: middle school ministry intern

Reports to: pastor

Position Type: full-time

Summary:

Naperville Presbyterian Church (PCA) is building a yearlong internship that combines both significant ministry to middle school students and robust mentorship. The middle school ministry intern will lead, teach, and disciple NPC's middle school students. At the same time, the intern will receive regular mentoring and care from the pastoral staff. As such, this position will have a focus on the development of leadership and ministry skill, as well as of personal character and a sense of ministry calling. The internship will entail meaningful ministry in the context of a Reformed, confessional church that longs for the doctrines of grace to foster a culture of grace—a gospel culture.

Responsibilities:

Middle School Ministry (30 hours per week)

- Planning, preparing, and teaching/facilitating weekly middle school touchpoints: Sunday school, youth group, and mid-week Bible study
- Discipling individual students
- Building community through planned social events
- Planning, organizing, and executing retreat(s)
- Recruiting and overseeing a team of volunteer leaders
- Communicating regularly with parents
- Attending regular meetings for staff and ministry directors
- Meeting regularly with pastor to discuss middle school ministry

Mentorship (10 hours per week)

- Meeting weekly with pastor for mentorship
- Completing assigned readings
- Observing meetings of the session and the diaconate
- Participating in men's ministry and small group
- Participating in the life of the church (e.g., attending worship services, serving in other capacities, etc.)

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree
- Professing Christian with Reformed convictions and a willingness to become a member at Naperville Presbyterian Church
- A love for Christ, a love for middle school students, and a love for connecting the two
