



Director of University Ministry Job Description

Citylife Presbyterian Church seeks to be a diverse community of grace that forms disciples of Jesus for the renewal of Boston and our neighbors. For more detailed information about Citylife, please visit our [website](#).

In this role you will have the opportunity to provide spiritual care and discipleship training for student leaders, execute the university ministry vision to build community, and foster connections between the university students and the rest of the Citylife congregation.

You will oversee and lead community formation and outreach to college students on college campuses (Campus Community Groups) and across campuses city-wide (University Ministry). A secondary part of this role will be to partner alongside the Pastor of Community and Formation to assist in church-wide initiatives of diverse, intergenerational discipleship and community formation.

Ideally the hope is for a candidate to plan on being in this role for 3+ years in order to maintain long-term spiritual support for students during this transitional period of life entering, throughout, and exiting college.

This position is expected to work 20 hours per week and pay \$30,000 annually.

Detailed responsibilities include:

- Meet with Pastors to shape the University Ministry around Citylife's core values and mission
- Oversee, plan and be present at all University Ministry initiatives
- Actively oversee the spiritual health of all University Ministry Campus Community Groups alongside the Pastor of Community & Formation
- Meet regularly with student leaders and students for spiritual formation, discipleship, leadership development and ministry planning
- Meet with students for spiritual care through campus visits and individual meetings
- Recruit new student leaders and adult facilitators throughout the year
- Manage University Ministry budget
- Convey all relevant University Ministry communications to the congregation
- Lead volunteer appreciation efforts
- Work with various leaders across the city (RUF, IV, Cru, CU) to forge creative partnerships
- Partner with [Justice and Mercy Ministry](#) to engage students in serving the City of Boston
- Collaborate with ministry staff to support church wide initiatives
