- Facilitate the growth and development of leaders and church members of G&P.
- Oversee and develop youth ministry directly and through volunteers.
- Be intentional in outreach to students, cultivating strong relationships and engaging in evangelism.
- Oversee and develop discipleship initiatives and processes.
- Assist Lead pastor with preaching and other pastoral duties.
- Direct the recruitment, training, and development of volunteers.
- Maintain a healthy family relationship with wife and children.
- Seminary degree or in progress.

Tactics- What action needs to be taken to accomplish strategy?

- Regular coordination and communication with the Lead Pastor and Executive Director.
- Prepare and conduct meaningful and purposeful weekly gatherings for youth.
- Communicate regularly with students, parents, and volunteers.
- Ability to train disciples by identifying, deploying, and developing their spiritual gifts and abilities.
- Embrace and enhance systems to manage tasks.
- Select or develop a meaningful and engaging curriculum with emphasis on a thoughtful scope and sequence.
- Must possess a strong work ethic and be self-motivated.

- Participate in regular coaching sessions with the Executive Director to develop priorities and leadership acumen.
- Able to lead and teach in large and small groups.
