MM&I would like to continue our effort of planting Reformed and Presbyterian Churches that will serve U.S. Military forces and their family members. We also want to plant churches in other locations of the Pacific for Internationals that speak English. Bi-lingual ministers are certainly welcomed. Fluency in English is absolutely essential.

MM&I is seeking ministers who are fully committed to hold tenaciously to the inerrant and infallible Word of God, the biblical administration of the Sacraments, and who is a minister whose prayers are deeply rooted in the Word of God. We are also a Confessional Church holding to the Westminster Standards as a testimony of our faith. We want the life of Christ to be a model for our ministry.
