Position Overview: Grace Presbyterian Church is seeking a full-time Music Director. The director would have leadership over the music during worship and developing/planning special worship services throughout the year. This person will work alongside the Senior and Associate pastors as an integral member of our staff. The Worship Director will serve to enrich and deepen the spiritual life and mission of the church through the planning, administration, development, expansion, and execution of our music ministry. We would also anticipate that the right candidate would also have a heart for Gospel ministry and discipleship. As such, would engage in leading some aspect of the church's ministry in keeping with the candidates calling, passions, and interests.

About Us: Grace Presbyterian Church is a growing church committed to the "means of grace." Grace is a biblical, evangelical, and reformed congregation of the Presbyterian Church in America and the North Georgia Mountain Presbytery. As a growing church, we currently have about 220 communing members, with an average worship attendance of just over 200. We have one worship service on Sunday morning that is blended in style.

- Basic Skills in composition and orchestration

- Experience in organizing, recruiting, rehearsing, and arranging both the instrumental and vocal elements of our Sunday worship, funerals, weddings, and special events, with excellence.
- A firm understanding of the liturgical elements and the ability to synthesize and bring coherence to a liturgy.
- A heart for gospel ministry in all its forms

Responsibilities

- Exhibit a fruitful relationship with Jesus, and a faithful membership of Grace.
- Collaborate with the pastors and Elders.
- Planning of weekly worship service with pastors
- Lead weekly rehearsals
- Play/Sing weekly during worship
- Recruiting/Training musicians within the church body as regular instrumentalists
- Oversight/maintenance of equipment, instruments, and budget
- Production of our weekly order of worship.
- Planning special worship services for Christmas, Easter, Reformation Sunday, etc.
- Engagement in other levels of discipleship and gospel ministry within the church.

Note: Our church is located several miles from Young Harris College, which has both vocal and instrumental programs. We would anticipate that a relationship with the college's music program, students, and professors would be cultivated.
