  - Serve as the team leader and supervisor to male middle school youth residents
  - Provide structured support, mentorship, and guidance to help each team member develop essential skills for success
  - Conduct annual performance reviews and regular 1:1 coaching meetings
- Create a volunteer culture and develop volunteers
- Develop Bible study curriculum and semester teaching series
- Purposefully connect with students, parents, and volunteers of different backgrounds
