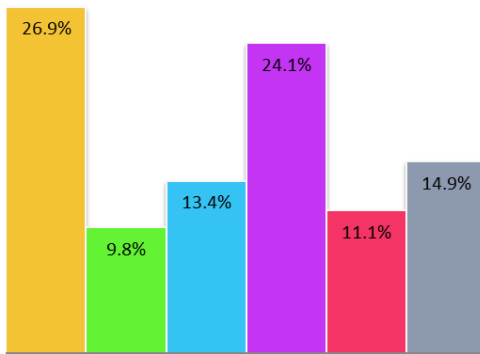

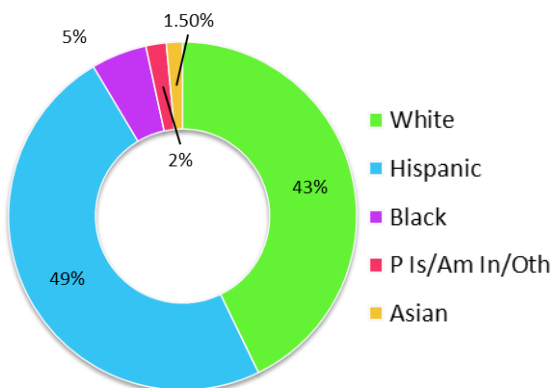
Age Demographics

Racial Demographics



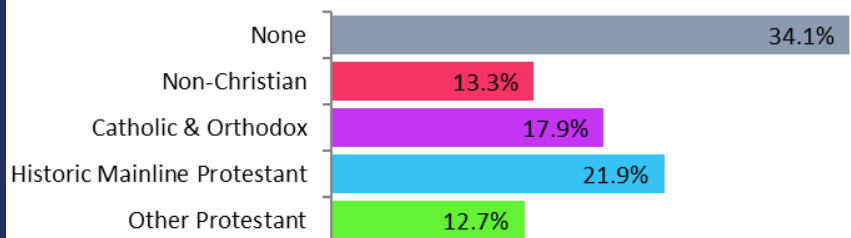

- Excellent K-12 schooling options including public, private/academy and a variety of homeschool groups
- Midland Community College, Odessa College and University of Texas Permian Basin campuses have a combined student population >18,000.
