- Apply the ordinary means of grace in youth ministry context

Lay Ministry Development

- Work with the Session to identify and nurture future church leaders
- Foster a culture of active lay participation in church ministry

Pastoral Development

- Preach regularly in evening services under the mentorship of the Senior Pastor
- Participate in pastoral care duties as part of the pastoral team
- Assist in worship service planning and leadership
- Engage in ongoing theological education and professional development
- Participate in Session meetings and church leadership activities
