Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist in Sunday morning Faith Kids ministry from nursery through 6th grade
- Attend worship each week
- Meet with the Faith Kids Director each week
 - Complete weekly readings and be ready to discuss with Faith Kids Director
- Participate in staff prayer and staff meetings
- Be familiar with the church's child protection policy and help ensure compliance with the policy
- Assist with Wonderlab outreach event (similar to VBS)
- Assist with the planning and coordinating of Summer Fun Days
- Plan and execute three special events for 5th/6th graders during the summer.
- Assist in the planning and execution of one end-of-summer/back-to-school event.
