HOUSTON PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH - Pastor job description

This church requires a bi-vocational or semi-retired pastor; someone who has an income in addition to his salary from the church. A manse is available which would be a part of the compensation package in addition to salary. Sunday School and Worship is held every Sunday morning, but no evening service. A Wednesday night Bible study and prayer meeting is held every week. The pastor would preach at the worship service and share in the teaching of the Adult Sunday School class with two laymen. In the past the pastor and the laymen have rotated teaching each quarter. The pastor usually leads the Wednesday night Bible study which normally is about 30 minutes; then the group updates the prayer list after which is prayer time.

Attendance at Sunday Worship is 25-27; Adult Sunday School, 12-14; Children's Class, 4; Wednesday night, 10-11. The WIC meets once a month with an attendance of 8-10; their Bible study is led by one of the members. There is a Church Family Dinner every other month, annual Fish Fry and an annual Christmas Brunch
